School Calendar:

The WHS 2014 calendar can be accessed through moodle and our website. It is an important tool for both students and caregivers to engage with as it indicates important events as well as being used to track assessment deadlines for students. Changes to the school timetable:

This year we are implementing some changes to our timetable. At the most basic level, this means some small shifts to the timings of our day. Year 9, 10 and 11 students begin their school day at 8.45am every day except Tuesday when they start at 10am. Year 12 and 13 students begin at 10am every day.

These changes mean that each student will spend at least 20 minutes every day in roopu time This time will be used to develop the skills of self reflection, goal setting and provide academic mentoring. Students will be given help to build effective time management and organisational skills. There will be a focus in roopu time on building strong relationships and explicitly communicating our values as a school, including the principles of restorative practice.
