Music Lessons are \$160 per instrument for the whole year. Students taking Music as an option in year 11,12 and 13 do not have to pay for lessons (one instrument only!) but still need to hand in their form.

All lessons are group Lessons for 1/2 hr per week

Wellington High School offers a great opportunity for students to learn to play an instrument from a specialised tutor. Most of these tutors come from the NZ School of Music and are exceptional Musicians; all of our tutors have years of experience in the Music Industry.

Lessons are held during class time on a rotating timetable to limit the effect on regular classes.

You will not receive personal notification as to your placement on the rosters, you will need to check these in week one.

Lessons starting Tuesday the 9th of February 2021. You commit to the entire school year!

If your name does not appear on the list within one week of lesson starting, please contact the TIC of Music via e-mail. **Timetables are displayed on the Music Departments notice board** in the hallway outside of the main music room and in the student hub on the school web side under Music (top right hand corner)

Changes to timetables are notified through the school's daily notice system, student's need to check these daily. Students MUST inform their tutor if they are going to miss a lesson please notify the teacher in charge (TIC) via email. Three missed lessons without a reason will result in the student being taken off the lesson roster, and no refunds will be made!!!

You need to return this form along with a payment of \$160 per instrument to the school office by Friday the 5th of February 2021. You may pay online or on the phone by credit card and send the form & proof of payment electronically to the above email address on due date. Forms and payments returned after that date will end up on a waiting list. No forms will be processed before the 4th of February. Placement will depend on a variety of factors and can't be guaranteed beforehand.

Note that students taking Music as an option for NCEA (Year 11, 12 and 13) will have first choice to lessons without charge (one instrument only).

Please note: We don't hire instruments. It is essential for students to have an instrument at home to practice.
