

Student Job Search

Who can use Student Job Search (SJS)?

Students intending to go to Polytech or Uni or a Private Training Provider:

If you are planning to study in the near future, you are likely able to use SJS as an intending student. The period of time you can use us for before your studies depends on when in the year you will start:

If your study date is between **January 1st - June 30th 2022** can begin to use SJS from **July 1st 2021..**

If your study date is between **July 1st - December 31st 2022**, you can begin to use SJS from **January 1st 2022.**

PLEASE NOTE: Many Polytech and Uni students finish their courses much earlier than secondary students and get out looking for work whilst you are still doing NCEA exams. The idea would be to tap into SJS ASAP. Make some time in the school holidays to register and start looking for jobs that may start after your exams are finished.

You will need to have Proof of Study

What is proof of study?

Because SJS is a service exclusively for tertiary students, they require documentation from your tertiary institution which confirms that you are either intending to study, currently studying or future study and includes:

- Your Name
- Name of your Qualification
- Name of your Tertiary Institute
- An indication of your course dates

This may include:

- Confirmation of study document or letter
- Offer of a place
- Confirmation of enrolment
- Receipt of fees confirmation

Intending Students may also use:

- A letter from your high school confirming your intention to study (we can help you with this)
- A halls of residence acceptance letter
