The University of Otago, Māori Health Workforce Development Unit is pleased to inform you that applications for the **Otago REACH (Realising Educational Aspirations for Careers in Health)** This scholarship is for Year 13 Māori secondary students interested in a career in health and is hosted by the University of Otago. The Scholarship covers; flights, accommodation, food, and activities over 3 days.

The main requirement is that students have aspirations for a career in health. Studying science subjects at levels 2 and 3, and their involvement or interest in Te Ao Māori will strengthen their application however we strongly encourage all students with aspirations in health.

The REACH Otago Scholarship provides opportunities for up to twenty Year 13 Māori students to spend three nights and days on the University of Otago's Dunedin campus. Students from across New Zealand experience university life first-hand: living in, and visiting, residential colleges; attending lectures; meeting current Otago students; and learning about the various degree and study options Otago offers, particularly in health.

Yoobee NCEA credit courses for Terms 3 & 4

Character Design

Combine your visual design skills with storytelling to create your character design. You'll learn how to use Adobe Photoshop like a pro-2D artist using Wacom tablets provided for in-class use. This programme covers the fundamentals of character design, including dynamic sketching techniques and the effective use of colour and light.

You will develop a character profile and story, plan your illustration project, and apply techniques for finishing a digital illustration to a high standard. This course is available in Terms 3 & 4, for 10 weeks, Level 3 with 10 credits attached.

2D Animation

Bring your animation to life by combining audio and visuals to create caution graphics using Adobe After Effects, Illustrator, and Photoshop. Learn to plan, prepare, and develop 2D animation like a boss. You'll learn idea development techniques, and create mood boards and a storyboard. This course is available in Term 3, for 9 weeks, Level 3 with 9 credits attached.

Term 3 - Wellington

Start Date: 22nd July 2024 End Date: 16th September 2024

Game Development

Learn the game structure and interface design to build an educational game using the Unity real-time development platform. This course includes an introduction to professional game design and development. You will learn coding fundamentals using the C# language, developing a programme to control gameplay and interaction. You will generate draft design concepts, create a game design mood board, and develop your code in the Unity game engine, including the grey-box testing and debugging process. By the end of this course, you will complete a simple, playable level and package it for distribution. This course is available in Terms 2 & 3, for 10 weeks, Level 3 with 11 credits attached.
