NCEA Experience

Provide experience of NCEA by each course assessing **one standard**.



Broad Foundations

Provide broad foundational knowledge and the skills needed to prepare for specialisation at **NCEA levels 2 and 3**.



No Level 1 Award

Not provide enough credits to gain the full NCEA Level 1 qualification.

Why we don't offer a full level one qualification at Year 11



Focus on Learning

Shifting the focus to learning as opposed to assessment

Level Two Pathway

Almost all students Achieve Level Two which automatically gives them Level One.

Longer Learning Time

Year 11s stay for longer in Term 4.

Inclusive Assessments

Opportunity to explore more inclusive forms of assessment

Student Wellbeing

Protecting the wellbeing of students by reducing the unnecessary burden of 3 yrs of NCEA

Course Flexibility

Provide greater flexibility for courses

Foundational Knowledge

Build foundational knowledge to enable success at year 12 and 13

Assessments



Course Structure

A mix of class tests, assignments, and one NCEA assessment (using NAME).



Assessment Formats

A combination of internally and externally assessed NCEA standards, and SOLO assessments.



November Exams

NCEA exams run during November while normal school lessons continue.



Literacy & Numeracy

Some students will need to sit literacy and numeracy exams if they have not gained the co-requisite in year 10. There is also the option of doing NUM112 to gain numeracy through achievement standards.

Co-requisites



Option 1: Literacy & Numeracy Standards

Learners need to achieve a 20-credit co-requisite through either the literacy and numeracy CAA, or te reo matatini and pāngarau standards.

At WHS, if the ākonga are ready to be assessed this will be in Year 10.

OR

Option 2: Approved Standards Pathway

Achieve through an approved list of literacy and numeracy-rich assessment standards.

At WHS, there is the opportunity to gain numeracy through approved internal assessment standards in Year 11.

To do these, students need to take NUM112.

Level 2 and 3



NCEA Level 2

To gain Level 2, you must achieve:

- **60 credits** at Level 2 or above, and
- **10 co-requisite** numeracy credits
- **10 co-requisite** literacy credits

NCEA Level 3

To gain Level 3, you must achieve:

- **60 credits** at Level 3 or above, and
- **10 co-requisite** numeracy credits
- **10 co-requisite** literacy credits
